Tribal Coordination and Consultation

Tribal Coordination

- Sharing information, education, and outreach.
- Most often at staff level.
- Can be part of Consultation.
- Cannot substitute for Consultation.
- Often consists of regular meetings.





Tribal Consultation

- Process of meaningful communication and coordination between agency and Tribal officials.
- Taken prior to agency actions or implementing decisions that may affect Tribes.

Preparing to Engage

- Establish Need
- Craft a Plan
- Build Consensus
- Start the Work
