F -- DE, PRIME HOOK NWR, LEAD SHOT ABATEMENT FROM SOIL (SRCSGT)

NAICS: 562910. THIS IS A SOURCES SOUGHT NOTICES FOR MARKETING RESEARCH PURPOSES ONLY. The U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service seeks qualified firms interested in conducting the excavation and removal of lead-contaminated soil and sediments from the forested wetland at Prime Hook National Wildlife Refuge in Milton, Delaware. Work is expected to include completion of a Health and Safety Plan; wetlands delineation and any necessary survey work; tree-species identification; a supplemental lead soil screening event to delineate the extent of contamination in the northern portion of the wetland; groundwater and surface water quality testing, decommissioning of unneeded monitoring wells; site preparation; Identifying and evaluating a source of clean fill; preparation of a Contaminated Materials Management Plan; implementing the remedy; conducting waste characterization and obtaining Solid Waste Disposal Facility approval; documenting that all field equipment were thoroughly inspected and cleaned of seeds, plants, insects, and other natural material that may foster the spread of invasive species; and preparing a Long-Term Stewardship Plan (LTSP) after the implementation of the removal action to describe any restrictions for future use of the site, long-term monitoring requirements and any other actions that are required to prevent or diminish future exposure potential. The U.S. Fish & Wildlife Service requires the removal and disposal of asbestos-containing materials from three buildings located at the Dawley Unit of Dungeness National Wildlife Refuge (NWR) and two buildings on Protection Island NWR, both located near Sequim, Washington. The Dawley Unit consists of a 4,393 sq. ft. main residence building built in 1935, the 120 sq. ft. Well House built in 1963, and the 72 sq. ft. Stone House built in 1939. The Protection Island NWR site consists of a 250 sq. ft. abandoned "red" cabin and a 150 sq. ft. college residence, both built in 1970. The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers requires a contractor to support the Rapid Response Program, Environmental Remediation Services (ERS) and other mission-related support services in the Continental United States, including Alaska and Hawaii, and outlying areas within the South Atlantic Division (SAD) Area of Responsibility (AOR). The successful offeror shall provide a time-sensitive response, environmental response, and/or remediation services at sites within the geographic boundaries of the contracts in accordance with the scope of this contract. The award will be an Indefinite Delivery/Indefinite Quantity (IDIQ) Single Award Task Order Contract (SATOC) with firm-fixed-price or cost reimbursement task orders. The majority of the task orders that will be issued under this contract will provide services related to requirements of the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA), the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation and Liability Act (CERCLA), the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Emerging Contaminant Program; the National Oil and Hazardous Substances Pollution Contingency Plan (NCP), Military Munitions Response Program (MMRP), the Clean Water Act, the Clean Air Act, National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA), National Historic Preservation Act, Endangered Species Act and other related Federal Programs in addition to state- and local-specific regulations/requirements dealing with hazardous waste management/disposal, radioactive waste/mixed waste management/disposal, and with Underground Storage Tanks (USTs), and other fuels related issues.
