NAICS: 541620. THIS IS A FULL AND OPEN COMPETITION. The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, Region 6, requires a contractor to provide nationally consistent technical assistance services to Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) On-Scene Coordinators (OSCs) and other federal officials implementing EPA's responsibilities under the national response system for the Superfund Technical Assessment and Response Team (START) class of contracts. These services primarily support Region 4 states (AL, FL, GA, KY, MS, NC, SC, and TN) and six Tribes (Catawba Indian Nation, Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians, Miccosukee Tribe of Indians of Florida, Mississippi Band of Choctaw Indians, Poarch Band of Creek Indians, and Seminole Tribe of Florida). Interested firms shall be prepared to provide scientific/technical support and align their activities with EPA activities to further the Agency's primary mission: The protection of human health and the environment. Contract responsibilities include providing: 24-hour, seven-day-a-week response activities, including emergency, counterterrorism, oil spill, federal disaster, Potentially Responsible Party, and minor containment response, and fund-lead removals; Preparedness and Prevention Activities; Assessment/Inspection Activities; Technical Support Activities; Data Management and Mapping Support; and Training. Z -- RENOVATION OF 11 H BARRACKS - MCGREGOR RANGE, NEW MEXICO (SRCSGT)

NAICS: 236220. THIS IS A SOURCES SOUGHT NOTICE FOR MARKETING RESEARCH PURPOSES ONLY. The Corps of Engineers, Fort Worth District, is seeking responses from qualified firms interested in supporting a design-bid-build project for the renovation of the 11 H-Barracks Buildings at McGregor Base Camp in New Mexico. This project will renovate the existing H-Barracks configuration into a U-shaped Barracks configuration. The renovation includes the 11 barracks buildings to meet current codes and standards. The design will include updating all the electrical, plumbing, lighting, communication, HVAC, a new fire suppression system, mechanical, roof, structural, floor, acoustic panel ceilings (APC), and abatement of asbestos-containing materials (ACM) and lead-based paint. This renovation shall include restrooms, showers, janitorial closets, vestibules, corridors, electrical and mechanical rooms, a laundry facility, interior walls shall be demolished, slab and exterior walls shall remain. The estimated construction price range for this project is between \$25,000,000 and \$100,000,000 with a 730-day period of performance. This anticipated project will be a competitive, firm-fixed price contract procured in accordance with FAR 15, Negotiated Procurement using "Best Value" trade-off process.
