- Several major contaminated land issues (eg Volgermeer polder in NL)n
- National R&D programs started to tackle contaminated land issues (NL: Nobis; UK; Clai;re, Germany: BMBF)
- New techniques and methods came in focus (Risk assessment, Monitored natural attenuation),

- Ad hoc communication between industry, consultants and regulators.




